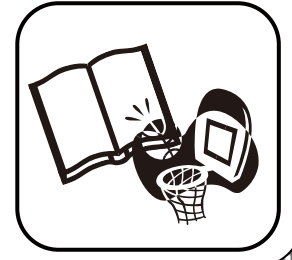

The hours of operation, usage type (group/individual), equipment that can be used, user requirements and usage fees depend on each facility. ### Azusawa Gymnasium

### **Itabashi Historical Museum**

The Itabashi Historical Museum is a facility where people can learn about Itabashi's history through its displays of fossils and old pottery excavated in Itabashi, historical documents, folklore materials and a traditional folk village house.

### **Itabashi Science and Education Hall**

Visitors can learn about science and scientific knowledge while having fun. The facility has a planetarium, panel exhibitions and other fascinating exhibits to enjoy.

### **Ecopolis Center**

Ecopolis Center is a hands-on educational facility. Visitors can learn about the environment through fun and interesting interactive panel exhibitions, resource rooms and various environmental lectures.

### **Itabashi Tropical Botanical Garden**

Recreating South East Asian tropical landscape and encouraging appreciation of marine life and plants, the Tropical Botanical Garden is an educational facility that offers people a chance to learn about global environmental problems such as tropical forest deforestation while also having fun.

### **The Uemura Adventure Museum**

Named after the adventure Naomi Uemura, who lived in Itabashi, this facility celebrates his sense of adventure. Photographs and some of the actual equipment that he used are on display.
